 - *TUESDAY, January 31, 2006 and/or*
 - *WEDNESDAY, February 15, 2006.*

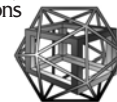
Top students in the AMC 10 and AMC 12 will be invited to participate in the upper levels of the Competitions:

 - *July, 2006, in Slovenia*
